

Friedensau Adventist University (Theologische Hochschule Friedensau) is a state-recognized institution of higher learning of the Seventh-Day Adventist Church. It has a School of Theology and a School of Christian Social Science.

The School of Theology will employ a

Professor of Systematic Theology and Adventist Studies

starting from the earliest possible date. The candidate will cover the entire field of Systematic Theology with a focus on Adventist Studies. Main areas are dogmatics, ethics, apologetics, and hermeneutics. Most of the teaching is in German, some of it in English.

The profile of the position requires a personality with a definite interest in research; experience in acquiring exterior funding is desirable. We also expect willingness to be involved in academic committees, and in managing and further developing course offerings. Moreover, we require readiness for interdisciplinary cooperation.

The prerequisites for employment are set out in § 35 (1) and (2), no. 1–4a and (3) HSG LSA. In addition, the candidate must be a member of the Seventh-Day Adventist Church and should have professional experience as a pastor for several years. Remuneration is according to the financial guidelines of the university. It is expected that full-time teaching staff take their residence on campus or in the area around Friedensau.
